In November 2015, the Council requested that the Administration study more sustainable funding options for enhanced street light areas in the City.

Among other recommendations, the study recommends moving to a service fee for Enhanced Street Lighting that would appear on customer's monthly utility bills, in place of the current SAA annual assessment. This change involves three actions of the Council - to identify the change of billing method, establish the rates, and to adopt the budget.
